

Homeric Hymn 9: to Artemis

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Ἄρτεμιν ὕμνει, Μοῦσα, κασιγνήτην Ἐκάτοιο,
παρθένον ιοχέαιραν, ὁμότροφον Ἀπόλλωνος,
ἥ θ' ἵππους ἄρσασα βαθυσχοίνοιο Μέλητος
ρίμφα διὰ Σμύρνης παγχρύσεον ἄρμα διώκει

- 5 ἐξ Κλάρον ἀμπελόεσσαν, ὅθ' ἀργυρότοξος Ἀπόλλων
ἡσται μιμνάζων ἑκατηβόλον ιοχέαιραν.

καὶ σὺ μὲν οὕτω χαῖρε θεαί θ' ὅμα πᾶσαι ἀοιδῆ·
αὐτὰρ ἐγώ σε πρῶτα καὶ ἐκ σέθεν ἄρχομ' ἀείδειν,
σεῦ δ' ἐγὼ ἀρξάμενος μεταβήσομαι ἄλλον ἐξ ὕμνον.

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¹"Ἄρτεμις -ιδος Artemis; acc. in either -ιν or -ιδα. ὕμνέω 2sg.imper. sing, praise.
κασιγνήτη ἡ sister. "Ἐκάτος ὁ the far-shooter, an epithet of Apollo.

²παρθένος ἡ maiden, virgin. ιοχέαιρα (ι) arrow-shedder, epithet of Artemis. ὁμότροφος ov reared (with) + gen. Ἀπόλλων -ωνος Apollo.

³ἄρδω aor.act.part. nom.sg.f. to water, give water (to). βαθύσχουνος ov with deep rushes.
Μέλης ητος the Meles river, near Smyrna; the partitive genitive is used with verbs of eating and drinking (Smyth §1355), “watered from the Meles...”

⁴ρίμφα swiftly, lightly. Σμύρνα Smyrna, in Ionia (Turkey). παγχρύσεος ov (v) all-golden.
ἄρμα ματος τό chariot. διώκω pursue, chase, hunt; drive.

⁵Κλάρος Claros, site of a temple of Apollo. ἀμπελόεις εσσα εν rich in vines. ὅθ' = ὅθι where. ἀργυρότοξος ov having a silver bow, another epithet of Apollo.

⁶ἡμαι pres.mid.3sg. sit. μιμνάζω stay, wait (for). ἑκατηβόλος ov far-shooting, an epithet of Apollo, but here feminine, of Artemis.

⁷οὕτω thus. χαίρω rejoice at, take pleasure in + dat. ἄμα together, at the same time. πᾶς πᾶσα πᾶν all, every. ἀοιδή ἡ song, singing.

⁸αὐτάρ however, but, topic switch. πρῶτα adv. first. σέθεν = σοῦ, gen.sg. of σύ. ἄρχομαι begin. ἀείδω sing. “I begin to sing of you (σε) first and from you (ἐκ σέθεν).” Think of ἄρχομ’ ἀείδειν repeated before καί.

⁹σεῦ = σοῦ, gen.sg. of σύ. μετα-βαίνω fut.mid.indic. pass over; pass on to a new subject, with ἐs. ὕμνος ὁ hymn, ode, song.
